

Carbon Monoxide and Gas Safety



Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colourless, odourless, tasteless, poisonous gas.

Because **you can't see it, taste it or smell it**, it's highly dangerous and in certain conditions can kill quickly and without warning.

Symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning



Headaches



Nausea



Dizziness



Breathlessness



Collapse



Loss of consciousness
